

OUR PARISH

- Amendment of Constitution. Regarding the amendment on Definition of Electoral Roll Membership, Quorum Number and AGM Adjournment Period, pray for (a) God to guard and guide the entire constitution amendment process, including consultations with SJSMers via the Cell Network, engagement at the Pre-AGM Forum on 22 Mar, and review by the Bishop and Diocese; (b) SJSMers to be participative and to engage constructively in discussions and any decision-making while maintaining the unity of the Spirit (Eph 4:3), leading to God's will be done at the AGM.
- Short-Term Mission Trips. Thank God for the harvest fields around us, including those in restricted access nations. • Substance Abuse. (ST: More drug abusers under 20 years old nabbed in 2024; youngest was 13, meth most commonly abused: CNB) Pray for (a) protection of our young from the scourge of drug addiction and better outreach to youths-at-risk to engage them productively; (b) more help for affected families to cope with living with addicted loved ones; (c) incarcerated addicts to hear the gospel and to experience Christ's love and hope for a drug-free life. • Peace for Ukraine. Pray for God's merciful intervention in the war in Ukraine and the protection of European continent's security. Amid the uproar at the US declarations delivered at the recently held Munich Security Conference, the subsequent European leaders' emergency strategy huddle, and the potential US-Russia deal to end the war in Ukraine, may the Lord direct and turn the hearts of relevant leaders like streams of water to accomplish His higher purposes, bringing about an end to the conflict in Ukraine and protecting the peace of Europe (Pr 21:1). Pray for the outpouring of the Spirit to bring a harvest of souls, and comfort and healing to those suffering and caught in the conflicts.
