ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE / START OF LENT Ash Wednesday Holy Communion Service: 5 Mar, 8pm



OUR PARISH

- Lent. Pray for the outpouring of God's grace upon us through the 40 days of Lent, starting from Ash Wednesday 5 Mar. May we intentionally slow down to meditate on the Lord Jesus' sacrificial love that led Him to the Cross. May God grant us a season of divine exchange, encountering Him and experiencing His purification, healing and revival as we humble ourselves, pray, seek His face and repent (2 Chr 7:14, Isa 57:15).
- The John123 Card & Alpha Training. Pray for the Holy Spirit to fuel us with a sense of urgency of time so as to be "the voice of one calling" (John 1:23). May God inspire us to use the Jn123 Card to (a) earnestly pray for the salvation of our family and friends; (b) reach out to and boldly share the gospel and our testimonies with them. THE WORLD


