Pray that God, who upholds the cause of the poor and the oppressed (Ps 82:3), will intervene to contain the humanitarian crisis. Pray that in His mercy, He will effect stronger social conscience and actions of wealthy nations to channel resources for the needy (Ps 146:6-7) and send aid swiftly to all facing hunger, diseases, extreme climate, conflicts and untold affronts to their human dignity.
