The Purpose of John's Message

"Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, and the crooked shall become straight, and the rough places shall become level ways, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God."

Obstacle#1 - SIN



But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Obstacle#1 - SIN



"You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?"

If John thought that they were genuine in their repentance:

- It was a declaration of the immensity of their sin
- And yet, their repentance was efficacious, bringing forgiveness, averting wrath.


"You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?"

If John thought that they were **not** genuine in their repentance?

- It was a declaration of the immensity of their sin
- No one warned them to flee
- It highlights a condition of spiritual blindness and hardness of heart.

⁸ Bear fruits in keeping with repentance. And do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you, God is able from these stones to raise up children for Abraham.

- This statement tells us that some were claiming to be 'sons of Abraham.'
- It also tells us that John did not agree with their claim to be 'sons of Abraham'

³⁹ They answered him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did, ⁴⁰ but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did.

Obstacle#2 Lacking Faith in God

Abraham was a man whose life was characterized by his faith in God. Therefore, the sons of Abraham are those who similarly demonstrate faith in God.

with?

Am I struggling in my faith in God?
