Lift up our authorities in ongoing negotiations with US counterparts that exemptions may be secured and livelihoods protected. Commit the five Economic Strategy Review Committees to God, seeking His outpouring of wisdom, insight and foresight as they formulate strategies to grow and strengthen our economy for the longer term.

THE WORLD

 Persecution in China. Amid widening suppression of unregistered house churches in China, let's pray for (a) Believers to stand firm, remain steadfast in faith, witness boldly and advance despite persecution; (b) The Lord's manifest presence with them (Ps 9:9) that His love rewrites the way they experience the suffering for Him. May Christ's light pierce the darkness of persecution, bringing Spirit-empowered growth of the gospel (Acts 8:1-4).
