

Pray for (a) more workers to be raised up for this vital vocation; (b) improved working conditions; (c) better access to expert guidance for complex cases; (d) opportunities for sabbaticals to recharge. May the Lord, who defends the weak (Ps 82:3), bless and sustain all who labour to safeguard children at risk.

THE WORLD

• Sudan Crisis. Appeal to God to pour out His mercy and justice (Ps 89:14) over Sudan as the nation is ravaged by civil war and famine. May He shield civilians, defend the helpless and heal the broken-hearted who cry out in despair. Pray for His hand to (a) break the power of evil and convict perpetrators of violence to turn from injustice; (b) expose and restrain the destructive activities of foreign extremist backers fuelling the conflict; (c) mobilize relief for the displaced, diseased and starving. May God keep the believers there strong in faith and open a door for their message (Col 4:3).
