

The Feast of Christ the King: Last Sunday before **Advent** 



#### Four Accounts of Jesus as King

- A. Visit of the Magi: Resulted in Herod's Massacre of the Innocents (Matt 2:1-18)
- B. Feeding of the 5,000: The crowds wanted to forcefully make Jesus King, but He withdrew from them. (John 6:1-15)
- C. Final Entry into Jerusalem: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Luke 19:28-40). Jesus' kingship is apparent.
- D. Trial before Pontius Pilate and the Crucifixion: "King of the Jews" (John 18:36-19:22). Jesus revealed the Kingdom but did not sidestep the cross to grasp the crown.

### Teaching about Jesus' Kingdom (1)

- It is <u>not</u> a physical domain, human organization, political entity or nation.
- Luke 17:21 "...the kingdom of God is in the midst of you" means:
  - "in you" an inner reality of souls living in submission to Jesus
  - "among you" relationships inspired and lived in His presence

### Teaching about Jesus' Kingdom (2)


- It is <u>not</u> of this world:
  - His mission is not to avoid death, but to die and rise above death.
  - His citizens are not called to defend Him, but to emulate His sacrificial life (Matt 16:24 "take up his cross and follow me").

### Teaching about Jesus' Kingdom (3)

- Already here Through his First Coming (His life, teaching, miracles, death, resurrection and ascension)
- Growing Through the work of the Holy Spirit through us his disciples (Acts 1:8 "be my witnesses")
- Not yet fully consummated Until his Second Coming (Matt 25 Parable of the Ten Virgins, Parable of the Talents and the Final Judgment between the sheep and the goats; Rev 1:7 "Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him...")

Perseverance: Our only response (1 Tim 6:11-14)

- "As for you, O man of God" (6:11) Our God-given identity.
- "flee these things" (6:11) Greed and false teachings (6:6-10)
- "Pursue <u>righteousness and godliness</u>, <u>faith, love</u>, <u>steadfastness</u>, <u>gentleness</u>"
  (6:11) – Growing in a cruciform faith
- "Fight the good fight of the faith... take hold of the eternal life" (6:12) – Don't take short cuts, give up or settle for less.



## Why persevere? Because our Coming King deserves it (1 Tim 6:14-16)

- "the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ... at the proper time" is for sure.
- "The Only Sovereign" God alone decides the timing and manner of Christ's First and Second Coming. There is no point in speculating.
- "King of kings and Lord of lords" Absolute dominion over all heavenly and earthly powers. There is no competition.
- "Alone is immortal, dwells in unapproachable light, no one has ever seen or can see" – Absolutely different from anything earthly or human. The very definition of "Holy". Inspires awe.
