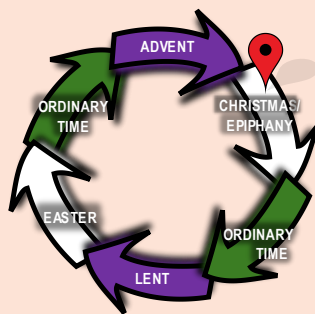

OUR PARISH

- **Prayer Training Retreat (29-31 Jan).** Praise God for the vision for SJSM to raise intercessors to stand in the gap and for raising leaders to train us! Thank Jesus, our Great High Priest, who intercedes at God's right hand (Rom 8:34) and teaches us to pray. May the Holy Spirit anoint Ms Brenda Goh, the trainer, and the facilitators; and ignite in all retreatants a deeper urgency and divine passion to be effective prayer warriors. Pray for the Spirit's strong presence and powerful movement, and protection and health for all at the retreat.
- **Word.** Praise Jesus who is the Word, Life and Light of men (Jn 1:1-4). THE WORLD

- **Asia.** Bring Asia before God, Whose plan stands firm over all nations and peoples (Ps 33:10-11), as many countries face external pressures (trade volatility, geopolitical shifts, security concerns, climate crisis) and internal struggles (fragile governance, slowing growth, rising debts, social divisions). Ask God to strengthen leaders with integrity, justice, mercy and wise stewardship of resources; and to sustain economies that protect livelihoods and dignity. Pray that the upcoming elections in Japan (8 Feb), Thailand (8 Feb), Bangladesh (12 Feb), Laos (22 Feb) and Nepal (5 Mar) will serve His purpose, that truth, justice and peace prevail.
