KNOW THE WORD (KTW) 2026 – EZEKIEL

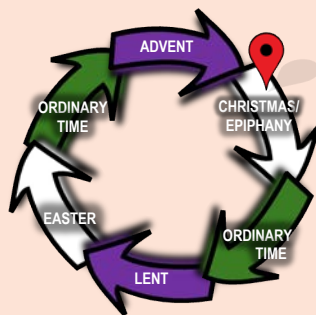
