THE ALPHA COURSE: MAR – MAY 2026

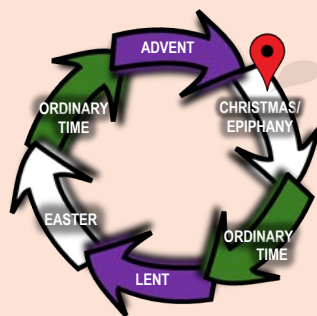
