Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent. As we reflect on our fallen human nature and our need for Christ's redemptive grace, the imposition of ashes on our forehead is an expression of humility and penitence, remembering that "(we) are dust and to dust (we) shall return." (Gen 3:19). May this service help us to enter the season of Lent to experience a time of deeper spiritual growth.

During Lent, we draw especially closer to Jesus as we remember his 40 days in the desert. To help us create that space to reflect, we intentionally simplify our lives.
