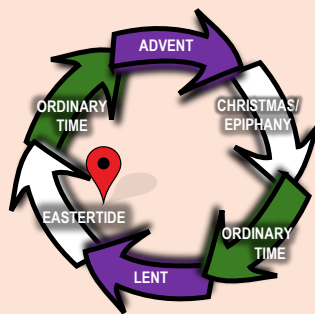

LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalm 106.6-24; Nehemiah 9.6-15; 1 Corinthians 10.1-13

COLLECT: Almighty God, who alone can bring order to the unruly wills and passions of sinful men: give us grace, to love what You command and to desire what You promise, that in all the changes and chances of this world, our hearts may surely there be fixed where lasting joys are to be found; through Jesus Christ our Lord. OUR PARISH

- **Parochial Church Council (PCC) Commissioning (26 April).** We praise God for a smooth AGM and give thanks to those who had served as PCC members for their faithful service. May God anoint the newly appointed PCC members to continue to serve with wisdom, administer with grace and lead by example as Christ-glorifying vessels (2 Tim 2:20-21), their service being an expression of their worship to Him so that others may emulate.

May God guard all hearts and minds in Christ, giving wisdom to those who ask Him (Jas 1:5).

THE WORLD

- **Peace for the Middle East.** Beseech God, who does according to His will among the nations and whose hand none can restrain (Dan 4:35), to govern the Middle East amid fragile ceasefires and maritime tensions. Pray that He turns the leaders’ hearts toward restraint and peace. Pray for (a) de-escalation across Gaza, Lebanon, Iran and surrounding waters; (b) restoration of safe navigation through the Strait of Hormuz and Gulf of Oman; (c) stability in global energy markets; (d) relief of suffering through secure humanitarian aid corridors. May He bring order out of chaos and may His sovereign purpose prevail over conflicts (Isa 46:9-10).
