LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalm 73.21-28; Job 14.1-2, 7-15; 19.23-27a; 1 Thessalonians 4.13-end

COLLECT: Almighty God, as we believe Your only-begotten Son our Lord Jesus Christ to have ascended into the heavens, so may we also in heart and mind thither ascend and with Him continually dwell; who is alive and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

OUR PARISH

- **Confirmation Service (17 May).** With rejoicing and thanksgiving to Father God, we welcome the 54 Confirmands into our SJSM family. Pray that they are being rooted and built up in Lord Jesus, and established in the faith to live a life patterned after His (Col 2:6-7). As Bishop Rt Revd Kuan Kim Seng lays hands on them, may the Holy Spirit fan into flame the gift of God in their lives. May they be strengthened as His instruments of edification, evangelism and service to a world in need of Christ (2 Tim 1:6-7).

OUR EXTENDED COMMUNITY

- **Little Seeds Preschools (LSP).** Exalt God for the 17 Little Seeds Preschools managed by the Anglican Preschool Services, providing quality, holistic, faith-based education for children aged six and below in Singapore. Pray that He will refresh and strengthen the teachers to serve lovingly with care, compassion and wisdom as they nurture our young ones in their formative years. May every child be seen, valued and nurtured in both mind and heart (Pr 22:6). Lift up the LSP (SJSM) in our Village that it will continue to thrive amidst challenges. May God faithfully provide for every need (Phil 4:19).

OUR NATION

- **Climate Adaptation.** Give thanks to God for the Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment in making climate adaptation, actions that reduce the impact of climate change, a national priority and for designating 2026 as the Year of Climate Adaptation. Pray for (a) effective heat resilience measures and divine protection from heat-related illnesses, especially for the vulnerable young, elderly and outdoor workers; (b) strengthened food and water systems to withstand hotter, wetter and drier extremes; (c) wisdom for the best plan to build up coastal and flooding protection. As we put our plans to work, may the Lord establish our steps (Pr 16:9).

THE WORLD

- **Food Insecurity.** The Iran war disrupts energy and fertiliser supplies, increasing costs and discouraging farmers across Asia, Australia and Europe from planting. Compounded by El Nino and extreme heat that further reduce crop yields, food insecurity in the Asia-Pacific is projected to rise by 24%, the highest increase of any region (UN World Food Programme). Implore God, who brings forth food from the earth (Ps 104:14), to (a) stabilise the Middle East ceasefires and maritime tensions, restoring energy and fertiliser flows; (b) make a way for farmers to keep planting even amid challenges; (c) protect vulnerable nations from food shortages and inflation. May food insecurity lead many to hunger for the Bread of Life (Jn 6:35).
