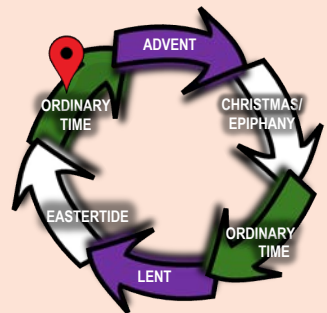

OUR PARISH

- **Families: Caregivers.** Give thanks to Lord Jesus for caregivers among us who sacrificially undertake the demanding unseen tasks of caring for loved ones who are elderly, unwell or have special needs. As they pour themselves out for their dependents, pray for rest-- physical, mental, emotional and spiritual, and that in giving, may it be 'given unto them, a good measure, pressed down, and running over' (Luke 6:38). - **Peace for Indo-Pacific.** Commit to God, who rules over the nations (Ps 22:28), Asia's premier defence summit, the Shangri-La Dialogue 2026 (29-31 May). Pray that His purposes for the Indo-Pacific prevail (Pr 19:21) as defence ministers and diplomats from over 40 nations address pressing security challenges. These include US-China rivalry, Middle East conflict spillovers and deterrence gaps, maritime flashpoints in the Taiwan Strait, South China Sea and the Strait of Malacca, cyber and subsea infrastructure threats, shifting alliances and rising defence spending. Pray that all engagements, including bilateral discussions, strengthen a just and lasting peace, protect the vulnerable and preserve regional stability, without falling into divisive power plays
