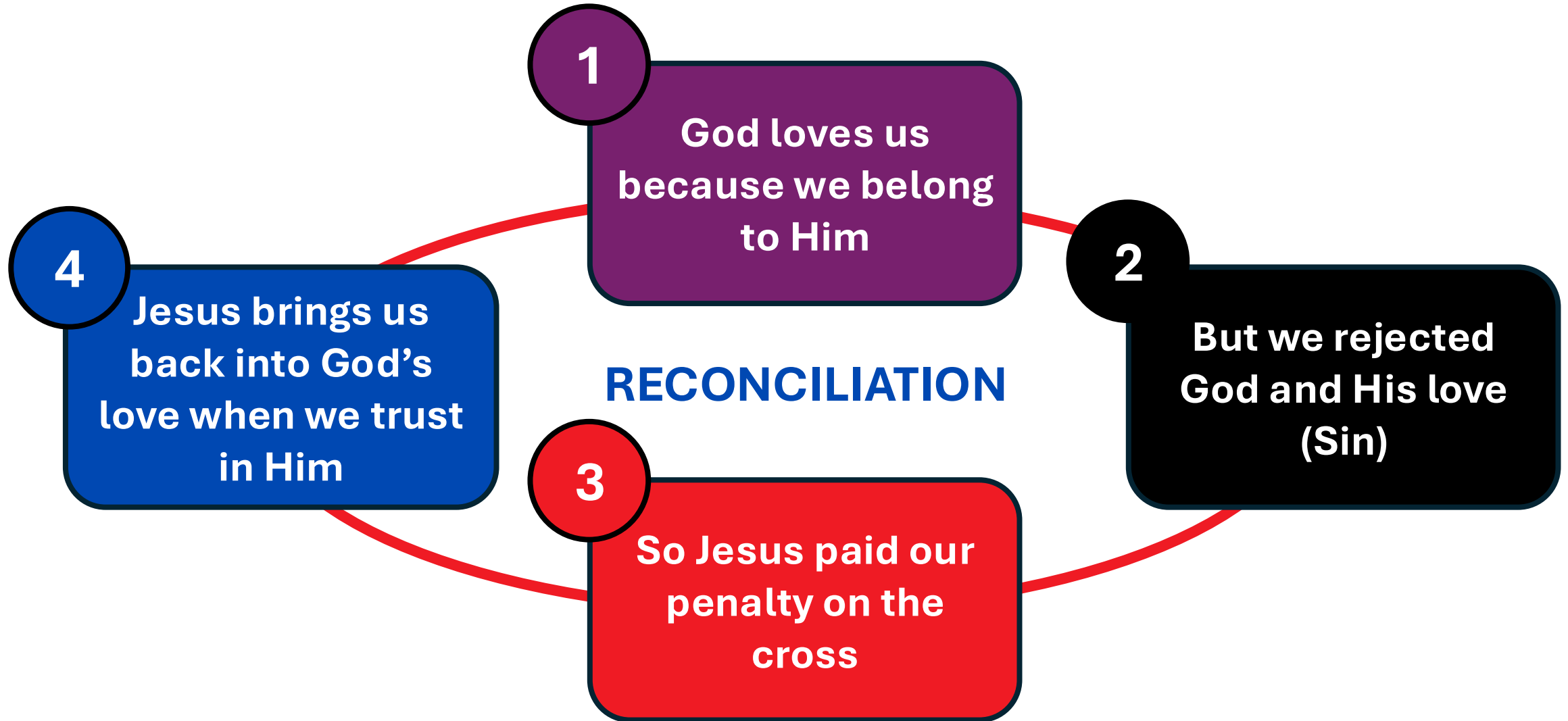

euangelion in Greek



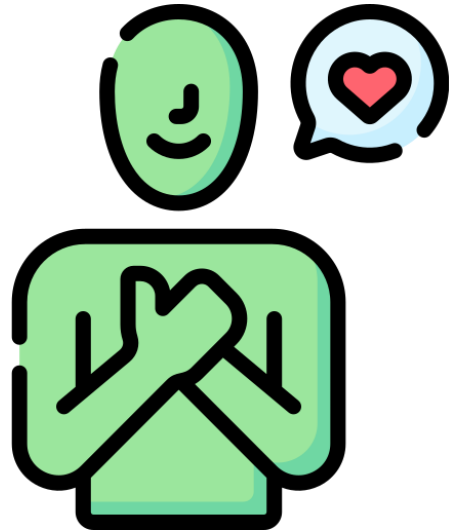
The Good News is about our Relationship with God

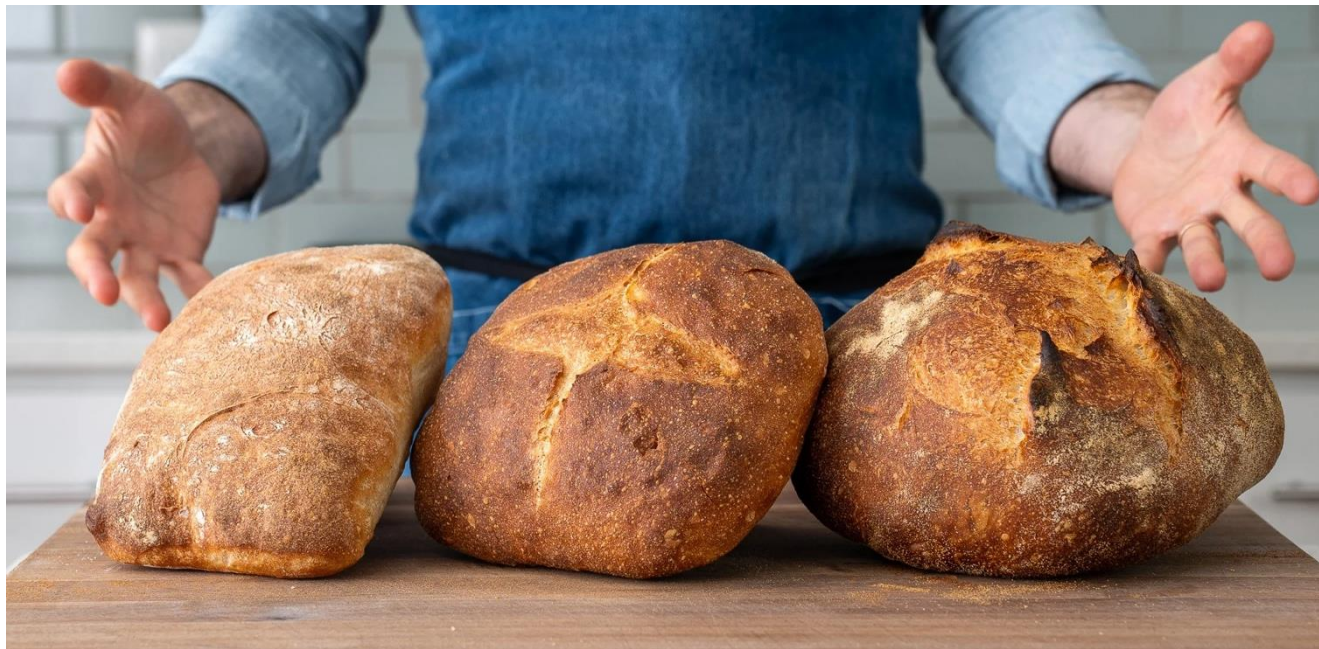

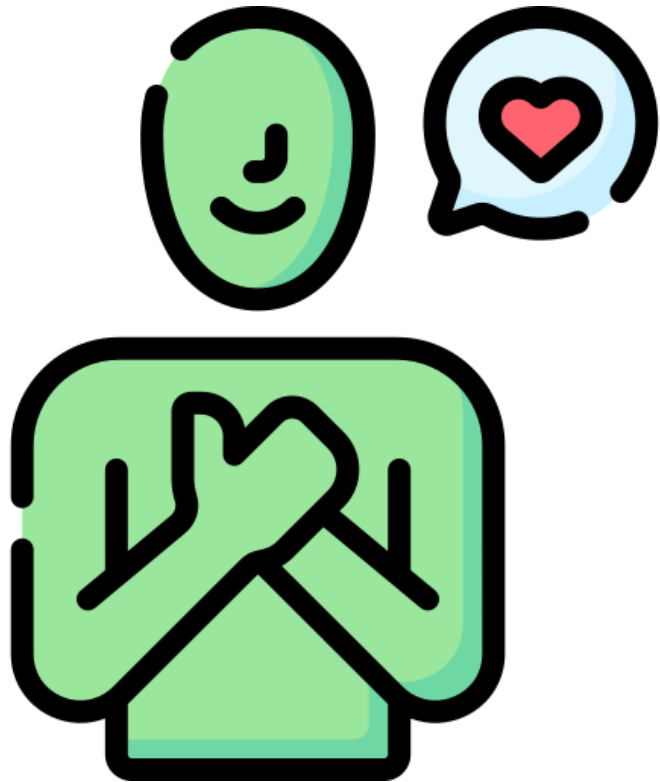

⁴ who **redeems your life from the pit**

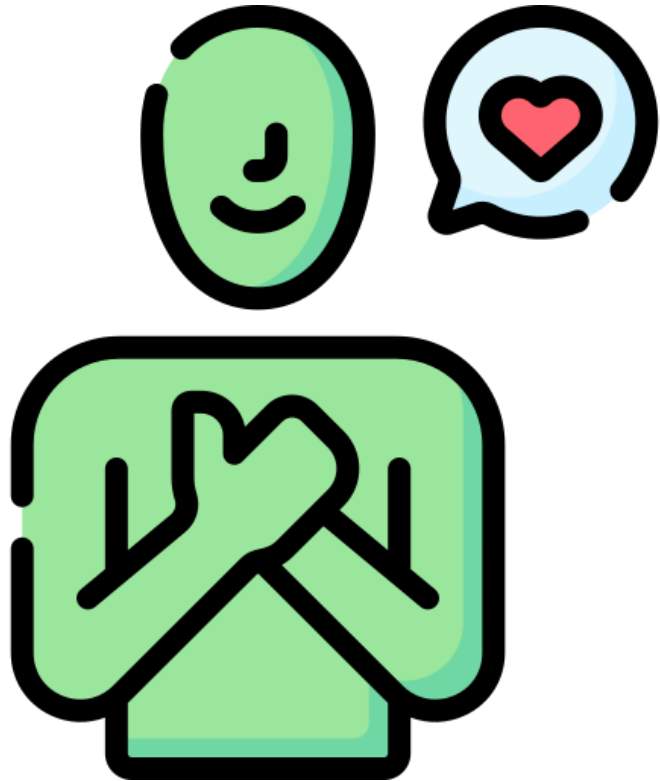
and **crowns you with love and compassion,**

Freedom, Under New Management

¹³ For he has **rescued us** from the kingdom of darkness and **transferred us** into the Kingdom of his dear Son, ¹⁴ who **purchased our freedom** and **forgave our sins**.

Treasure in Jars of Clay

⁷ But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us. ⁸ We are afflicted in every way, but **not crushed**; perplexed, but **not driven to despair**; ⁹ persecuted, but **not forsaken**; struck down, but **not destroyed**... (2 Cor 4:7-9, ESV)

Be the Good News, **embody** the Message



¹ Long ago... God spoke to our fathers
by the prophets, ² but in these last days
he has spoken to us **by his Son...** (Heb 1:1-2)

And the Word **became flesh** and **dwelt**
among us,
and we have seen his glory,
glory as of the only Son from the Father,
full of grace and truth.
(John 1:14)

Eight Ways to **Be** the Good News

1. **Be prayerful:** “pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers” (Luke 10:2)
2. **Be present with non-believers:** “Go...” (v.3)
3. **Be confident in the Lord:** “...as lambs among wolves... Carry no moneybag...” (vv. 3-4)
4. **Be positive and friendly:** “Peace be to this house!” (v.5)
5. **Be focused:** “Remain in the same house... Do not go from house to house...” (v.7)
6. **Be humble and willing to share life:** “eat what is set before you” (vv.7-8)
7. **Be responsive to the needs of others:** “Heal the sick in it...” (v.9)
8. **Be confident that God is there:** “say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’” (v.9)



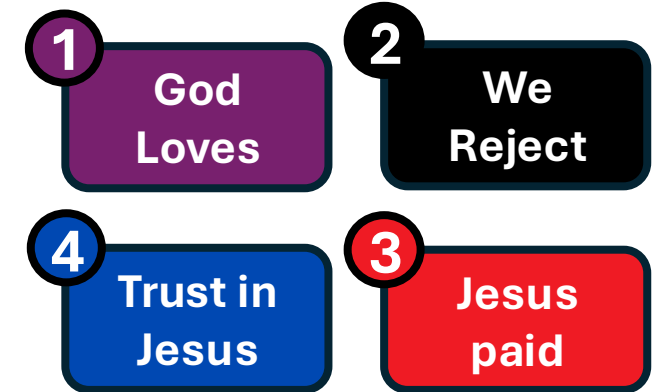
Bring the Good News




- ¹⁴ **How then will they call on him** in whom they have not believed? And how are they to **believe in him** of whom they have never heard? And **how are they to hear** without **someone preaching?** (Rom 10:14)
- ¹⁵ But in your hearts **revere Christ as Lord.** **Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have.** But do this with **gentleness and respect,** ¹⁶ **keeping a clear conscience...** (1 Peter 3:15-16)

Eight Ways to Bring the Good News

1. Share how God is currently working in your life.
2. Share how you are facing your life challenges with God's help.
3. Share your faith by praying for their needs.
4. Share how you are different from before.
5. Share how you turned to Christ.
6. Share how they can find out more and experience God through Alpha.
7. Share the four-point Good News message.
8. Share how they can put their trust in Christ.
