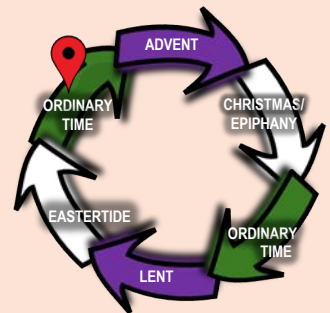

1st SUNDAY AFTER TRINITY

LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalm 38; Deuteronomy 6.10-end; Acts 22.22—23.11

COLLECT: Almighty and everlasting God, by whose Spirit the whole body of the Church is governed and sanctified: hear our prayer which we offer for all Your faithful people; that each in his vocation and ministry may serve You in holiness and truth to the glory of Your name; through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

OUR PARISH

- **Church Camp: As Jesus Loves (8-11 Jun).** Exalt Lord Jesus for His sacrificial love as the atoning sacrifice for our sins (1 Jn 4:10-11). Pray for (a) a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit over the 600+ campers to have receptive hearts and personal encounters that anchor identity in Christ for lasting transformation; (b) strong anointing over Ps Tak Meng, speakers Ps Benny Ho, Ps Zane Liew, Ps Ian Choo, worship teams and facilitators (1 Cor 2:2-6); (c) divine protection, good weather, good health, smooth logistics, unity and joy; (d) campers to carry God's presence, drawing those around to Jesus.
- **Families: Raising Resilient & Relationally Wise Kids (27 Jun).** Praise Father God for the joy and privilege of parenthood, a noble task to steward His gift of children and launch them as arrows for His kingdom (Ps 127:3-5). Pray that many parents of children (14 years and below) sign up for this course by 8 Jun. May parents be continually refreshed by the Spirit, renewed by God's Word and rooted in Christ's love, reflecting His character and modelling a life of faith for their children. May they leave behind a godly legacy of intimacy with Christ.

OUR EXTENDED COMMUNITY

- **Missions.** Praise the Lord of the Harvest for our SJSM missionaries across Central Asia, China, Cambodia, Japan, Hong Kong, Korat, Laos and Timor Leste. Pray that they (a) continually abide in Christ amidst unique field challenges (Eph 6:10-18), resting in His shadow (Ps 91:1); (b) experience God's favour, open doors and softened hearts receptive to the gospel. For those missionaries attending church camp, may they be refreshed. May their "Meet Our Missionaries" sharing at the camp ignite SJSMers' hearts and stir a deeper desire to serve and support missions.

OUR NATION

- **Government.** Singapore faces complex challenges: the climate crisis, global conflicts, inflation, rapid AI advancements, a super-aged society and mounting healthcare demands. Lift our government to God (1 Tim 2:2), asking for wisdom and divine strategies as leaders work towards solutions. May they lead with righteousness, integrity and moral courage, steering our nation on the right path. May God grant our leaders renewed strength, protection and blessings for them and their families.

THE WORLD

- **Climate Crisis.** Following World Environment Day (5 June), beseech Creator God, who cares for the land (Ps 65: 9-13), to heal the earth. May the Church mourn the root sin of climate crisis: self-interest over the poor and future generations. Pray for (a) wisdom and cooperation beyond national economic interests among negotiators at the UN Climate Meetings in Bonn (8-18 June); (b) God's mercy over the developing El Niño, that may rise to "Super El Niño", threatening severe droughts, heatwaves, wildfires and floods; (c) protection and disaster preparedness for vulnerable communities facing worsening environmental instability.
