OUR PARISH

- **Intercessors Gathering (2 Jul).** All glory to Lord Jesus, our Great High Priest, who lives to intercede for us (Heb 7:25). - **Great Commission: Advancing World Missions.** Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, for He has purchased for God persons from every tribe, language, people and nation (Rev 5:9). Pray for an unprecedented surge in world missions. Implore God for (a) Spirit-empowered boldness for persecuted believers to proclaim Christ; (b) more labourers for the harvest; (c) wisdom for agencies to finish translating Scripture for every people group; (d) redemptive use of digital tools where missionaries cannot go. May God break the power of darkness so the unreached see the light of the gospel (2 Cor 4:4).
