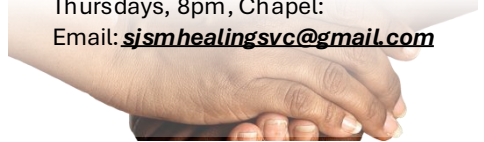

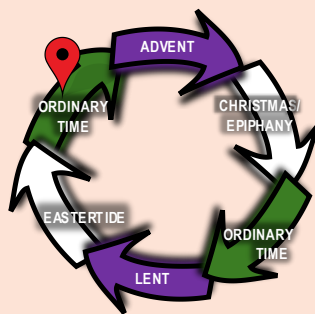

OUR PARISH

- **Word.** Exalt Lord Jesus, the Word made flesh (Jn 1:14).
