

MISSIONS TRAINING, EQUIPPING AND GIVING

Involvement in missions supports spiritual formation in many ways, and the equipping for missions is an important part of one's discipleship journey. Longer term missions placements would require more in-depth and sustained preparation.

Missionary Apprenticeship Programme (MAP)

The MAP is a 1-2 year programme for confirmed SJSM members to prepare concertedly for longer-term missionary service. They should be active cell members, engaged in missions and serving in ministry.

Missionary Internship Programme (MIP)

The MIP is a minimum 3-month programme for confirmed SJSM members to discern God's calling for longer-term missionary service. They should be active cell members and serving in ministry.

Preparation for Short-Term Mission Trips and Vision/Exposure Trips

All trippers are expected to undergo relevant training before they embark on short-term cross-cultural trips. This contributes to their physical safety and spiritual growth, as well as enables the work in the field to flourish.

Missions Equipping Platforms

Seminars and talks on Business as Mission and Bi-Vocational Missions Work & Tentmaking have been organised in the past. Workshops can follow!

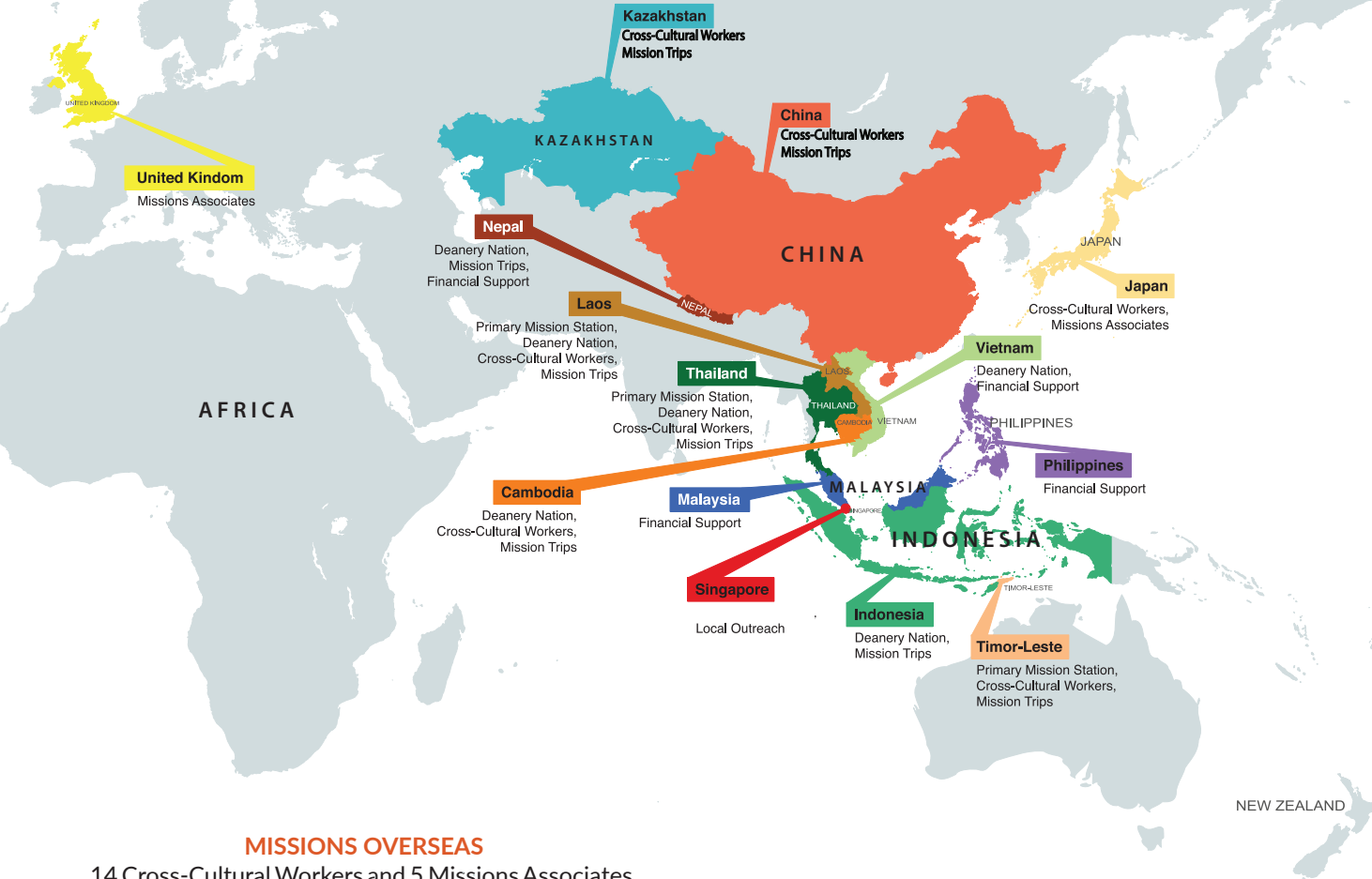

MISSIONS OVERSEAS

14 Cross-Cultural Workers and 5 Missions Associates, often joined by 2 Non-Residential Missions Workers and SJSM mission teams, serve in countries, including the deanery countries of the Diocese of Singapore, ie. Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Nepal, Thailand, Timor-Leste and Vietnam.

In major part, SJSM's work is carried out at our mission stations located in Cambodia, Laos, Thailand and Timor-Leste. It involves church-planting, language and vocational skills training, medical assistance and community development for the alleviation of poverty.

Further afield, ministries undertaken by our missionaries are in diverse spheres, such as those of business, medical aid, support for the disabled, outdoor adventure, campus outreach and bible translation; these are in both rural and urban settings.

MISSIONS IN SINGAPORE

Our local missions efforts are currently directed at reaching guest workers, mainly from Bangladesh and India, who reside in foreign workers dormitories.

Recently, Neighbourhood Tours (around Dover and Ghim Moh Link) and Creation Care Nature Walks have been organised for SJSM members to be more acquainted with our surroundings and to befriend others in our community.

MISSIONS AWARENESS AND PARTICIPATION

Events which lend understanding to missions to SJSM members of all ages, so that SJSM Church participates in Missio Dei, the ongoing mission of God in the world today:

Missions Engagement Weekend (MEW)

This is our annual church-wide awareness-building platform. Missions participation applies to ordinary Christians of all ages and backgrounds. We all have a part to play in God's mission and our responsibility is to find our place in His grand redemption plan. The whole church must be mobilised as witnesses for the glory of God!

Missions Fellowship Teas (MFT)

MFTs are organised to build missions-minded communities. These gatherings can be organised according to interest in geographical areas as well as interest in missions topics e.g. Bi-Vocational Missions Work, Creation Care.
