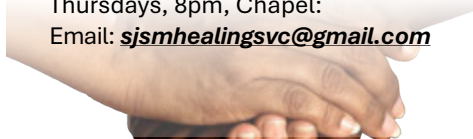

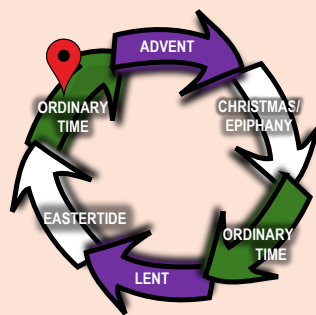

OUR PARISH

- **Baptisms (22 & 23 Aug).** Hallelujah! We praise Abba Father and rejoice with the 19 baptism candidates taking this step of faith, identifying with Christ in His death and resurrection. May He help them overcome sin's power, and empower them to live the new life following Him (Rom 6:4-6), through His Word and Spirit. May fellow SJSMers come alongside them, as one body (Eph 4:4-6), shining as beacons of Christ's light and drawing many to Him.
- **e-Seasons of Life.** Thank God for anointing our past and present writers and editors to encourage many through reflections, testimonies and staff interviews. Commit the publication's new digital format to Lord Jesus. May He expand its reach in the digital world and stir more SJSMers to share their faith stories for His glory (Rev 12:11). May He grant the team creative wisdom to write more impactful articles that deepen believers' faith and touch seekers' hearts.

OUR EXTENDED COMMUNITY

- **Heartfriends Student Care Centre (HSCC).** Praise Almighty God for His faithful providential care over HSCC, its staff and children. Pray that He (a) keeps HSCC a safe sanctuary where children learn, play and rest after school; (b) strengthens staff to nurture each child with love and compassion, and empowers SJSM volunteers to lead programmes that sow and shape kingdom values into hearts (Ps 90:17). May more children enrol in HSCC that it may thrive and flourish. May the AAC-KopiStop National Day celebration (@SJSM on 15 August) bring joy and strengthen bonds among everyone involved (Pr 16:3).

OUR NATION

- **Haze.** Our nation faces the risk of severe haze, particularly from August to October, as El Nino strengthens and a positive Indian Ocean Dipole is expected to develop, bringing hotter, drier conditions. Pray for protection for those most vulnerable: outdoor workers, children, the elderly and those with medical conditions. May families, schools and care facilities stay vigilant, responding to the air quality. May God, who sends lightning with the rain and brings out the wind from His storehouses (Jer 10:13), release rain to extinguish regional fires and winds to clear the air.

THE WORLD

- **Youth Radicalisation.** INTERPOL (July 2026) and the Global Terrorism Index 2026 identify youth radicalisation as a global counter-terrorism challenge, with extremists exploiting social media, online gaming and encrypted spaces to recruit vulnerable youth. Call upon God, the fountain of life and source of light (Ps 36:9), to (a) guard young hearts and minds from deception, hatred and violent ideologies; (b) galvanize more governments and technology companies to disrupt extremist recruitment, counter algorithmic radicalisation and create safer digital spaces; (c) grant parents and educators wisdom and vigilance to nurture deeper engagement; (d) guide youth to find their identity in Christ, not online ideologies.
