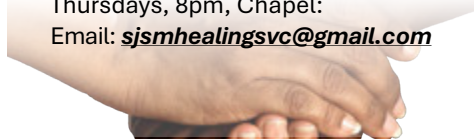

The Despairity Gospel: Hope In An Uncertain World

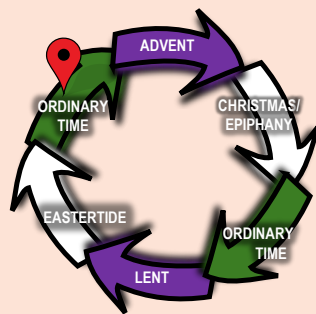

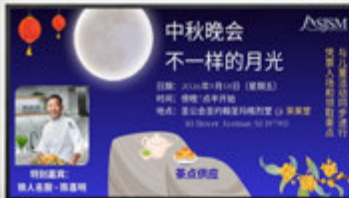
