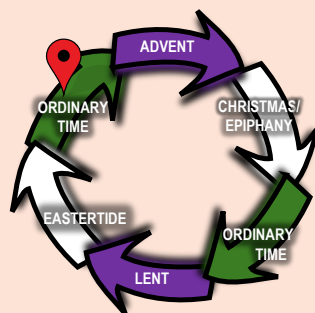

OUR PARISH

- **Hearing The Voice of God Retreat (18-20 Sep).** Praise Lord Jesus, our Good Shepherd who laid down His life for His sheep, that we may have abundant life (Jn 10:10-11). Pray against distractions, that retreatants may hear and heed His still, small voice (Jn 10:27) and encounter Him personally and powerfully. May they grow in intimacy, anchor their identity firmly in Him and leave with transformed hearts and minds to love God and others more deeply.
- **Alpha Day (19 Sep).** Exalt God for the 15 in-person and 1 online Alpha groups currently running! Beseech the Holy Spirit to manifest His presence and power on Alpha Day, convicting hearts to repent and turn to Lord Jesus (2 Pet 3:9). - **Unhealthy Air Quality.** As Singapore and neighbouring regions experience elevated PSI levels due to El Niño and persistent forest fires, we look to God for relief and community well-being. Pray that God will send rains to wash away atmospheric pollutants, suppress regional hotspots, and cool the land (Ps 68:9). Pray for timely medical care and safe indoor shelter, especially for young children, the elderly and those with chronic respiratory conditions. May refreshing rain soon restore our environment (Ps 65:9-10).

THE WORLD

- **Political Extremism.** Amid the influence of hardline political movements in many countries, societies are experiencing deep division, declining institutional trust and political polarisation. Call upon God, who rules over the nations (Ps 22:28), to break "us versus them" mentalities and restrain hatred, hostility and political violence. Pray for (a) wisdom and integrity for governments to uphold justice, order and human dignity, and treat vulnerable groups and immigrants with compassion; (b) empowerment for the Church to be salt and light, engaging society wisely, exposing deceptive rhetoric and reflecting God's heart to a divided world.
